Culinary Arts 2021 Rules

All first-time exhibitors must have an exhibitor number. There will be no MTAS membership fee deducted from prize money in 2021. All classes are open competition to all exhibitors, including Juniors, except those marked with Age Restrictions. Only one entry is allowed per category.

Exhibits must be brought to the Agricultural Hall – South end large rollup door no later than 11:30 a.m. on Friday, August 20th and picked up Sunday August 22, 2021 between 1:00 and 3:00 p.m.

All pie entries are a generous piece of pie displayed on a small plate in a plastic bag.

Note that entries are not refrigerated. Chairperson is not responsible for goods after **3:00 pm Sunday August 22, 2021**. All entries must include a completed and folded tag and be displayed on paper or plastic plates in plastic bags or see-through covering.

Prize money will be paid out by mailed cheque. Please be sure we have your mailing address when entering exhibits.

Daddy's Tea Biscuits

2 cups Flour

4 teaspoons Baking Powder

1 tablespoon Sugar

½ teaspoon Salt

½ cup Butter

1 Egg + Enough Milk to make 1 cup of liquid (approx. ¾ cup milk)

1. Crack egg into a 1 cup measure and add enough milk to fill cup.
2. In a separate bowl, mix flour, baking powder, salt and sugar.
3. Cut butter into flour until crumbly.
4. Add egg mixture to dry ingredients to make a soft dough. Knead lightly.
5. Roll out and cut into 2 inch rounds.
6. Bake at 425 F for 10 to 12 minutes
