Exhibits are to be picked up at 4:00 p.m. (NOT BEFORE) on Sunday August 21, 2022. The Committee is not responsible for uncollected exhibits or prizes.
- Judging will take place on Friday, August 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Please put name, age, phone number, address, and exhibitor's number on each entry tag.
- **DO NOT** put any personal info on the exhibits themselves (only the entry tags) or if you do, (i.e. Signature at the bottom of an artwork) make sure it is covered.



70-1. - A line drawing on white paper, 21.5cm x 28cm (8 1/2 x11).



Drawing must be done with black ink or marker, (as it would appear in a child's colouring book).

- 3. Poster size: Minimum – approximately 22cm X 28cm, without border**  
**Maximum – approximately 28cm X 44cm, without border**
- 4. Each entry must be centered on a CARDSTOCK or BRISTOL BOARD backing exposing approximately a 5.5 cm border on all four sides.**
