8. Female born prior to January 1st, 2022 with her own 2024 natural, purebred, tattooed, calf at foot. Female and calf must be shown as a unit but the calf is eligible to show as an individual in classes 1, 4, and 9, 10, and 11 group classes.

9. Progeny of Dam: Two (2) animals – the progeny of one dam, must have shown in previous classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor.
10. Breeder's Herd: Group of animals bred by the exhibitor- both sexes represented and at least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must be shown in previous classes and limited to one exhibit per exhibitor.
