Rules and Regulations

- 1. All exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor.
- 2. Use fresh flowers in arrangements unless specified otherwise.
- 3. One entry per exhibitor in each section.
- 4. Exhibitors must supply all vessels for their exhibits.
- 5. No flexible containers to be used. Be sure containers are heavy enough to hold top heavy flowers such as gladiolus.
- 6. Containers should be as specified as they are considered in the judging.
- 7. Entries will be received between 9:00 AM and 11:30 AM, Friday, August 15, 2025.
- 8. Exhibits must be left until 4:00 pm, Sunday, August 17, 2025. No early removals please.
- 9. See complete MTAS Rules and Regulations on the website.

All floriculture entries must be registered using the Assist Expo link that will be available on the www.southmountainfair.ca website closer to fair time. Deadline for online entries is midnight Thursday August 14, 2025

Last minute entries (without registration on Assist Expo) are allowed and will be registered on Friday when brought to the Exhibit Hall.

All exhibitors must check in with the registration desk when arriving at the Exhibit Hall.

CLASS 1: CUT FLOWERS

Prizes: 1st \$4.00, 2nd \$3.00, 3rd \$2.00

- 1. Asters, 3 blooms, one or mixed colour.
- 2. Collection of annuals, 3 different kinds 2 spikes, sprays or stems of each kind, in one container labelled.
- 3. Collection of perennials 3 different kinds, 2 stems of each, in one container.
- 4. Coneflowers, 3 blooms, any colour.
- 5. Cosmos, 5 blooms, mixed colours.
- 6. Dahlias, over 6", 1 bloom.
- 7. Dahlias, 2 blooms, one colour, under 6" in diameter.
- 8. Gladiolus, 1 spike of one colour, in a suitable container.
- 9. Gladiolus, 1 spike, one variety, bi-colour or tri-colour, in a suitable container.
- 10. Gladiolus, 5 spikes of any colour, bicolour or tricolour, in a suitable container.
- 11. Geranium, 1 bloom with own green foliage.
- 12. Hydrangea, coloured, 3 stems, with foliage.
- 13. Hydrangea, white, 3 stems, with foliage.
- 14. Hydrangea, largest bloom.
- 15. Marigolds, 1"-2" in diameter, 3 blooms.

- 16. Marigolds, 2"-4" in diameter, 3 blooms.
- 17. Marigolds, white or cream, 3 blooms
- 18. Pansies, with own foliage, 3 blooms (no violas)
- 19. Petunias, any type or size, 3 blooms
- 20. Phlox, 3 sprays, perennials, any solid colour.
- 21. Phlox, 3 sprays, perennials, multi-coloured blooms.
- 22. Rose floated in a rose bowl, with foliage.
- 23. Rudbeckia, 3 blooms.
- 24. Snapdragons, 3 spikes, mixed colours.
- 25. Sunflowers, 1 stem, under 5 inches, any colour.
- 26. Sunflowers, 1 stem, over 5 inches, any colour.
- 27. Sweet peas, 3 stems, assorted colours.
- 28. Zinnias, 1"-3", 3 blooms with own foliage.
- 29. Zinnias, over 3", 3 blooms with own foliage.
- 30. Nasturtium, 3 blooms with own foliage
- 31. 3 different hosta leaves, any size or colour

CLASS 2: POTTED PLANTS

Prizes: 1st \$4.00, 2nd \$3.00, 3rd \$2.00

- 32. Foliage, coleus in a pot
- 33. Succulent, any kind, in a pot
- 34. Potted fern

CLASS 3: BEST PLANTER

Prizes: 1st \$10.00, 2nd \$7.00, 3rd \$5.00

- 35. Garden planter using assorted flowers in bloom, and vines (vines optional).
- 36. Outdoor hanging flower container.

CLASS 4: ARRANGEMENTS

- 38. "Welcome to Fall" An arrangement using fall colours on a grapevine wreath.
- 39. "Pint Size" An arrangement in a pint mason jar to be viewed from all sides.
- 40. "Summer Light" An arrangement in a 4 sided lantern using pastel coloured flowers.
- 41. "Candle Pot" A Christmas arrangement in a clay pot no larger than 8 inches in diameter featuring a candle or candles, using evergreens and garden flowers.
- 42. "Tea Time" An arrangement using a teacup with saucer as the container.
- 43. "A Garden Bowl" An arrangement of garden flowers, herbs and vegetable foliage in a kitchen bowl no larger than 8 inches in diameter. \$30 gift certificate sponsored by Harvest Barn
